OPEN UNIVERSITY TUITION INCREASE



When you register for Open University this fall, you will notice a modest tuition increase of \$5. Member tuition has increased from \$45 to \$50, and non-member tuition has increased from \$75 to \$80. Membership with The Shepherd's Center remains \$25.

Open University is one of the Center's biggest sources of revenue, helping to defray increasing operating costs. Tuition has not been raised since the fall of 2018. This change was approved at the meeting of the Board of Directors in May, 2023.
